We also discuss our Life Skill Goal of the quarter. The 1<sup>st</sup> quarter our goal was "*Scoops of Kindness*". The 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter our goal was "*Jars of Generosity*". For the 3<sup>nd</sup> quarter our goal was for reading month, and now our 4<sup>th</sup> quarter goal is "Bubbling with Effort" to coincide with spring testing.
